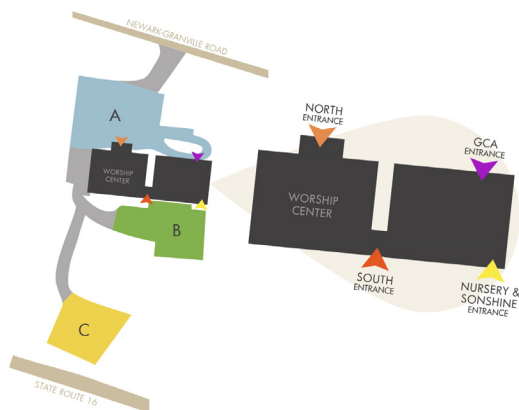

## Crisis Ministry Prayer Chain

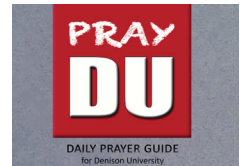

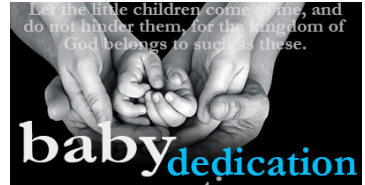


#### Volunteers Needed for Worship KidStyle

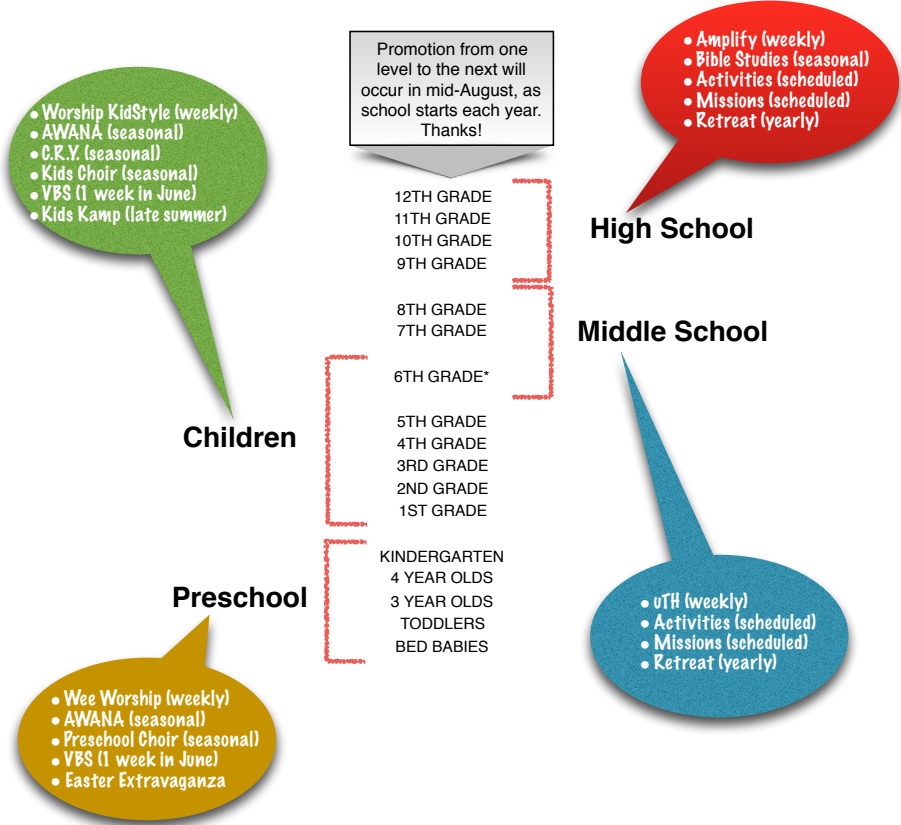

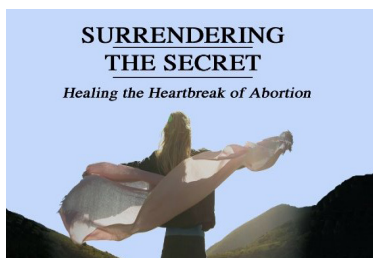

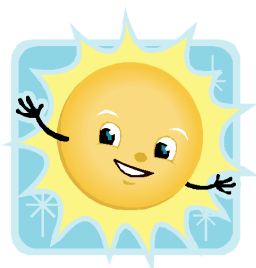

- \* Emotional and spiritual healing from loss through abortion or miscarriage

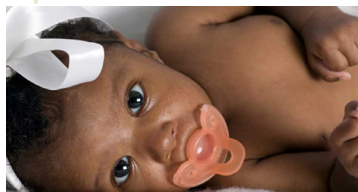
